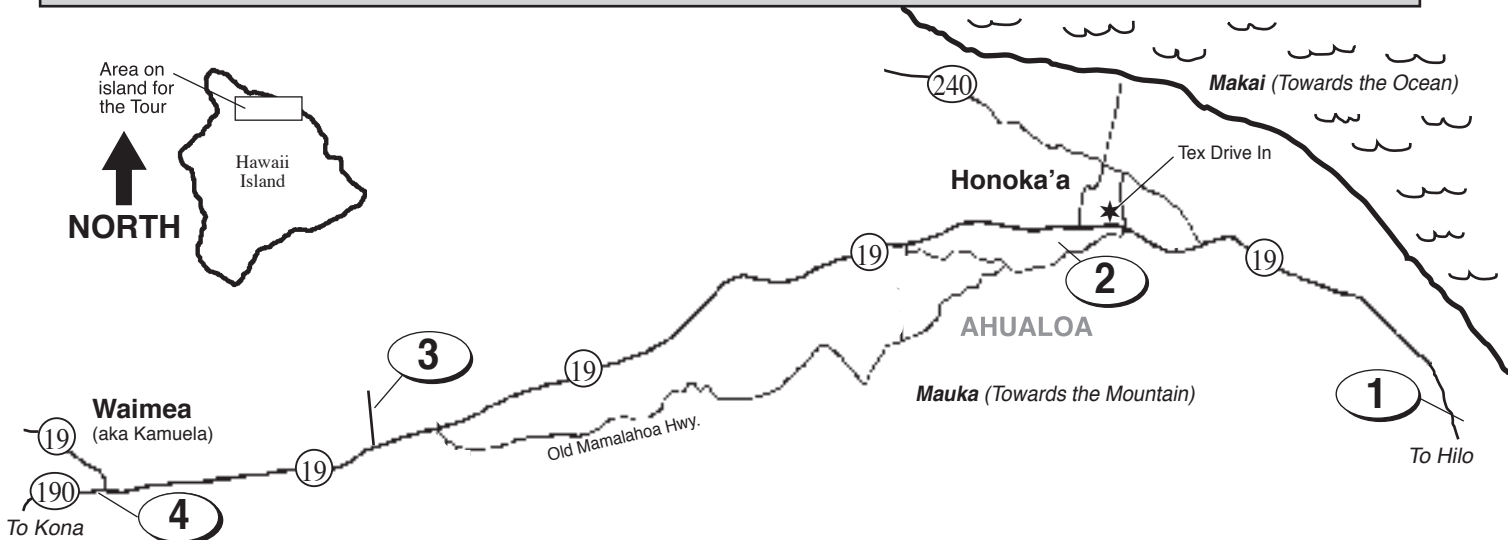

Mahalo for joining us on our 9th Annual Art Studio Tour

Come rain or shine . . . We encourage you to visit the studios in any order. Since traditional North/South directions get confusing on winding island roads, our directions are "island style". Mauka meaning mountain side and makai meaning ocean side. We use Tex Drive In as a starting point located on Hwy. 19 at the Honoka'a 43 mile marker. Watch for the red and white "Art Tour" directional road signs. There also will be colorful banners at each studio.

At the first studio you visit, ask for a door prize drawing ticket and have it stamped at each studio.

At the last studio you visit drop the completed ticket in the container.

1. RACHEL BAKER

Glass fusing demonstration. Leaded glass panels and fused glass bowls, jewelry and more.

BILL JAEGER

Stained glass demonstration. Stained glass panels, tropical glass designs on functional items.

KATHLEEN JAEGER

Mosaic demonstration. Glass mosaics and acrylic paintings.

Studio located on Hwy 19. outside Honoka'a between the mile markers 38 and 39.

Directions from Hilo: Take the belt road (Hwy. 19) towards Honoka'a/Waimea (north). When you pass Pa'auilo town, look for mile marker 38. Travel another 0.3 miles past mile marker 38, turn right into the paved driveway with white address sign 44-1924.

Directions from Studio 2: Go back to Hwy. 19 and drive towards Hilo. Continue on highway, watch for mile marker 39. Travel 0.7 miles past mile marker 39, turn left into the paved driveway with white address sign 44-1924.

Driveway has several curves. At top of hill continue on gravel drive to second house at the end of the driveway. Please park on the grass. Follow the signs to the studio which is on the bottom level. Ph: 776-1913, Bill's cell: 345-1549.

2. HUGH JENKINS & STEPHANIE ROSS

Blown glass demonstration: spice bottles, kuttrolf vanilla bottles, and of course spheres. Hand blown glass vases, bowls, glasses and more.

PAULA NURSE

Demonstrating wire wrapping with very fine gold and silver wire. Fine gold and silver wrapped jewelry, including precious and semiprecious stones; one of a kind designs.

Directions from Honoka'a: From Tex Drive In on Hwy. 19, turn mauka on Mauna Loa Road.
Directions from Studio 3: Get back on Hwy. 19 and head east towards Honoka'a. The scenic drive on Hwy. 19 will take you through cattle country and rain forests to Honoka'a Town. Travel to mile marker 43 (Tex Drive In is makai side of Hwy.). At that intersection turn mauka on Mauna Loa Road.

Take an immediate right on Old Mamalahoa Hwy. Drive 0.6 miles on a winding road, with four narrow bridges. The studio is on the makai side of the road at 45-3524. If you wish you can drive in for drop off or pick up, however due to limited turnaround space please park out along roadside. Ph: 775-1167.

3. KAREN THRASHER

Torch worked glass demonstration at her Waimea studio. Silk and acrylic paintings and prints, hand blown glass, horse hair raku pottery.

Studio on Puanaunu Place off Hwy 19. between the 52 & 53 mile marker.

Directions from Honoka'a: Starting at Tex Drive In (Hwy. 19 mile marker 43) drive west towards Waimea approximately 9.8 miles. Turn right on Puanaunu Place.

Directions from Waimea: Drive east from the intersection of Hwys. 19 and 190 approximately 4.5 miles from light in Waimea town past the Mealani Research Station on the right. Turn left on Puanaunau Pl.

It's the eighth house on the right (red with brown trim), 64-5224 Paunuanu Place. Ph: 895-5011.

Painting demonstration. Showcasing paintings in acrylics, watercolor, oils and multimedia.

The Firehouse Gallery is located at Waimea's Historic Corner at the intersection of Hwys. 19 (Lindsey Rd.) and Hwy. 190 (Mamalahoa Hwy.) in Waimea.

Directions from Honoka'a: From Tex Drive In drive towards Waimea on Hwy. 19 approximately 14.5 miles to the intersections of Hwys. 19 and 190.

Parking in rear (turn south at streetlight) or library parking west of Gallery. ADA accessible and rest rooms available.
